



FULL THROTTLE TEAM BUILD EXPERIENCE

OVERVIEW

Participants will be introduced to NASCAR through both its rich legacy and its present-day teams and crews. Over the three-hour program, participants will engage in a series of activities that highlight careers in the sport, providing hands-on experience and fostering an appreciation for the people and moments that have shaped NASCAR. As part of the program, team members will utilize and develop key skills—communication, strategy, leadership, creativity, and more—to complete program activities.

Participants will be divided into teams of approximately 10. Each team will receive a schedule of activities. The entire group will collectively participate in the opening activity and then regather for the closing. During the two 60-minute portions, teams will rotate between activities according to the instructions. At the closing, teams will be recognized. Additionally, each team will be photographed, and every participant will receive a copy of their team photo.

SCHEDULE AND ACTIVITIES

30 MINUTES

- Welcome, outline activities and challenges
- Watch 15 minute film of History of NASCAR

60 MINUTES

Each group will have 60 minutes to complete their designated tasks. At the end, groups will switch activities for an additional 60 minutes.

- **Qualify to Race:** Can you make the fastest laps to receive a time to qualify to race?
- **In the Driver's Seat:** Step into a race-simulated experience to become one of fourteen drivers on track and racing for the win. Can you get to 1st and maintain your lead?

- **10 Seconds Flat:** Pit crews are skilled professionals that can change a tire, lift the car on a jack, give the car fuel and fix or repair the car in 10 seconds. Working in a team of three, try to coordinate the fastest pit stop to help your driver back on the track. *Have a camera ready to capture this high impact excitement.*
- **Who's the Driver:** Complete a photo "scavenger hunt" in search of artifacts within the Hall of Fame.



60 MINUTES

Engineering for Victory (Car Build): Teams will be provided with a specific set of parts to design and build their own race cars. A set of parameters will be provided to start this activity. Teams will then engineer and test their cars until the time runs out. Teams will measure their designed cars with a race to victory lane. Have a camera ready to capture this high impact excitement!



30 MINUTES

Final Lap Shoot Out: This final task involves trivia focused on 2 key topics. Your company trivia (questions can be provided to us, or we can research) and knowledge gained throughout the days program. Points are tabulated here and winner is announced.
