Description

The Trustees of the California State University requests written proposals in accordance with the contract documents for the installation and repair of security alarms and closed-circuit television systems at San Francisco State University. Work includes all labor and materials necessary for the installation, repair and monitoring of closed-circuit video systems (CCTV) , alarm & security systems, and data/voice/cable television systems. Contract duration is for one (1) year with options to be extended for up to four (4) additional one-year terms. Estimated contract value is \$30,000 annually.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting and jobsite walkthrough is scheduled for 9:00 AM, November 12, 2009 in the Russian Hill Room of the Seven Hills Conference Center on the campus of San Francisco State University. Parking is available for \$1.00 per hour or \$5.00 per day in Lots 20 and 25. Bidder must register at: "<http://www.planetbids.com/SFSU/bidframe.cfm>" to download the RFP documents. Contractor must have a minimum of three (3) years working in a University (or higher education institution) environment, provide a minimum of five (5) verifiable references of similar projects, and possess a current Class C-7 or C-10 Contractors license. Each bidder will be required to submit written proposals for four (4) sample projects, including costs of labor, materials, tools, equipment, apparatus, transportation and applicable taxes.

Sealed proposals are due no later than 2:00 P.M., December 3rd 2009 in the Office of Rose Balancio-DiMaggio, Contracts Coordinator, Procurement & Contracts, at San Francisco State University, 1600 Holloway Avenue, Corporation Yard Room C-140, San Francisco CA 94132 or they will be rejected. It is the bidder's responsibility to insure their proposals are received by Ms. Balancio-DiMaggio prior to the proposal submittal deadline; the University

assumes no responsibility for proposals delivered late by the US Postal Service or by any other means of delivery.

Additional bid requirements include \$1,000.00 bid security in the form of a certified bank or cashier's check or bidder's bond, a minimum 3% Disabled Veterans Business Enterprise (DVBE) participation, payment of prevailing wages, Nondiscrimination in Employment and Fair Employment Practices.
