At the July CGCC-NIGP Meeting in Panama City, we heard from a new cooperative purchasing organization, **GovMVMT**, starting in February 2022.

GOVMVMT was founded around one basic principle: "creating a true, not-for-profit, public-focused program that is centered around providing dependable programs and services with the public's interest at the forefront of everything we do." David Kidd, the founder of GovMVMT, shared insightful tips for how to find the best cooperative agreements available to government entities: Look for a supplier commitment for the best value, check administrative fees, confirm compliance, and ask for verification sheets.
