## Resolution Recognizing March as National Procurement Month

- 2 WHEREAS, public procurement is an essential function of government, providing for the purchase of
- 3 goods and services necessary for the safe and effective operations of the state/territory, including purchases
- 4 for education, health and human services, transportation, administration, and others, and
- 5 WHEREAS, the work of the government procurement offices benefit state/territorial agencies, local
- 6 governments, school districts, and citizens alike through the application of the principles of fiscal
- 7 responsibility and ethical use of taxpayer dollars for the operations of government, and
- 8 WHEREAS, public procurement requires specific knowledge and skills to maintain fair and competitive
- 9 purchasing practices, conduct thorough market research, administer effective negotiations for the mutual
- 10 benefit of governments and suppliers, and successfully monitor and evaluate all government purchasing
- 11 contracts, and

- 12 WHEREAS, in addition to the purchase of goods and services, public procurement adds value by
- 13 performing such functions as executing, implementing, and administering contracts, developing strategic
- 14 procurement strategies and cultivating working relationships with suppliers and other departments within
- 15 the organization, and
- 16 WHEREAS, state and local governments everywhere are supported by a highly qualified and dedicated
- 17 procurement staff who demonstrate professionalism on all levels and understand the importance of the
- 18 work they perform, and
- 19 WHEREAS, the National Lieutenant Governors Association supports and practices the public
- 20 procurement values and guiding principles of accountability, ethics, impartiality, professionalism, service,
- 21 and transparency established by the Institute for Public Procurement (NIGP) as fundamental tenets of the
- 22 public procurement profession, and
- 23 WHEREAS, many organizations around the nation and units of public procurement hold activities and
- 24 events annually in March to further educate and inform the general public on the critical role that public
- 25 procurement plays in our government's success.
- 26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the National Lieutenant Governors Association joins
- 27 lieutenant governors and seconds-in-command across the country to proclaim March 2023,
- 28 March 2024, and March 2025 as "National Procurement Month."
