WHEREAS: in addition to the purchase of goods and services, procurement professionals add value to the organization by performing such functions as executing, implementing and administering contracts, developing strategic procurement strategies and cultivating working relationships with suppliers and other departments within the organization; and

WHEREAS: public procurement professionals in the City of Scottsdale and in other public and private organizations have tremendous influence on the economic conditions in the United States, with accumulative purchasing power running into the billions of dollars; and

WHEREAS: the public procurement professionals in the City of Scottsdale are committed to providing high-caliber strategic, logistical and operational support of all departments within the City of Scottsdale; and
