Recitals

1. The Parties entered into a Contract (MA2025009) for Cybersecurity and Information Security Services for NASPO ValuePoint, effective November 7, 2025.
2. With this Amendment No. 1, the parties desire to update the Contractor information per the approved assignment, renew the contract, and obtain Contract certification of compliance for Americans with Disabilities Act, as further detailed below.

Agreement

Based on the above recitals, and good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Contract is amended as follows:

1. The Contractor is now CGI Technologies and Solutions, per the written consent of the Administrator of the Division of Purchasing and the Idaho Board of Examiners. The Administrator Acceptance of Assignment and Idaho State Board of Examiners Request for Recognition of Assignment are included with this Amendment as Exhibit A, below.
2. The Contract is renewed from November 1, 2026, to October 31, 2027.
3. The Contractor shall ensure all digital products, services, and content provided under this Agreement comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), Section 508 (as applicable), and WCAG 2.1 Level AA. Specific requirements are outlined in [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\) 2.1 AA](#).

This requirement applies to all websites, applications, software, documents, multimedia, and any digital tools or services provided or procured for the State of Idaho.

Failure to meet WCAG 2.1 Level AA may result in any remedies available under Idaho procurement law, including but not limited to:

- Requiring the Contractor to cure deficiencies
 - State-performed testing or remediation at no cost to the State
 - Withholding payment
 - Termination of the Contract
4. Except as expressly modified in this Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the Contract remain in full force and effect.
5. This Amendment is effective upon the date of the last signature below. In no event will this Amendment be effective until executed by the Department of Administration.

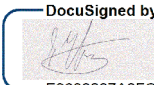

Dear Sirs:

The Idaho Division of Purchasing (DOP) has received a request to assign Contract MA2025009 from Online Enterprises, Inc. dba Online Business Systems to CGI Technologies and Solutions Inc. This memo presents background information and analysis for your consideration.

Based on the available information, DOP has determined that the assignment is in the best interest of the State and respectfully requests the Board of Examiners to recognize the assignment.

Background

On January 22, 2026, DOP received an email from Online Enterprises, Inc. informing us that Online Enterprises, Inc merged with CGI Technologies and Solutions Inc. We followed up with Online Enterprises, Inc. and 1) confirmed the merger went through as of March 1, 2026, 2) provided the assignment documents, and 3) reviewed the assignment process and expectations with them. On April 23, 2026, DOP received all required documentation from Online Enterprises, Inc. and CGI Technologies and Solutions, Inc.

Reason for Assignment

Online Enterprises, Inc. has merged with CGI Technologies and Solutions, Inc. and is requesting assignment of their respective contracts, according to the attached documents provided by the companies. The State of Idaho will continue to offer cyber security and information security services through the master agreement and National Association of State Procurement Officials (NASPO) for the foreseeable future and needs the contract to continue, subject to the Administrator's and Board of Examiner's approval.

ANALYSIS OF REQUEST TO ASSIGN

When analyzing the appropriateness of assigning a contract that was issued pursuant to the competitive bid process, we've reviewed whether the assignee is equal to or better than the assignor, and the potential benefits and risks to the State to assign the master agreement rather than performing a full rebid.

Quality of Assignee

The assignee, CGI Technologies and Solutions Inc., started taking over responsibilities of the Master Agreement in March of 2026. The communication we exchanged with CGI Technologies and Solutions Inc. has reassured us of their ability to provide top customer service, and that they will continue to provide the specified cyber security and information security services in a manner that is equal to or better than Online Enterprises, Inc.

Risk Analysis

This master agreement was the result of a multiple award through a Request for Proposal (RFP) performed by the State of Idaho with aid from various states associated with NASPO. Rebidding the master agreement is impractical due to the multiple award process, communication with NASPO, and the time invested, therefore; DOP does not find a rebid to be in the State's best interest.

Conclusion

There has not been any disruption in service with the master agreement in this request. We are confident CGI Technologies and Solutions Inc, will continue providing equal or greater performance over the remaining life of the master agreement. Taking all this into consideration, we respectfully ask that you accept the request to assign the above referenced master agreement from Online Enterprises, Inc.

Thank you for your consideration of this matter. I will be available at both the subcommittee and Board meetings to answer questions and provide any requested information.

These costs include but are not limited to reasonable attorney's fees for the evaluation of the conflicting claims and any expenses necessary for such evaluation, including but not limited to, photocopying, transcript costs or any travel costs as necessary. It

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is intended that the State of Idaho be made whole in the event that there is any dispute over the sums involved.

(3) As to any payments made by the state to Assignee on the above-referenced obligations, Assignee agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the State of Idaho for any claims made against the state resulting from such payments to Assignee. It is intended that the State of Idaho be made whole in any dispute involving payments made to Assignee.

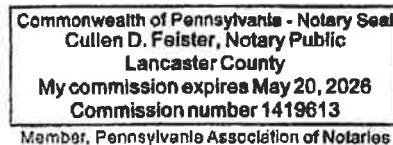

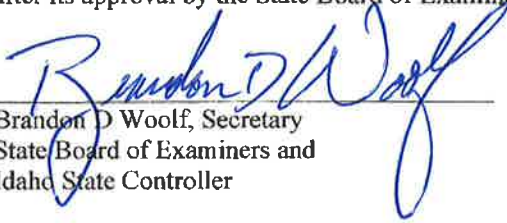

THIS ACCEPTANCE OF ASSIGNMENT (Acceptance) is entered by and between the State of Idaho ("State"), Online Enterprises, Inc. dba Online Business Systems ("Assignor"), and CGI Technologies and Solutions Inc. ("Assignee").

RECITALS

- A. The State issued the following contract: Master Agreement MA2025009, Contract for Cybersecurity and Information Security Services ("Contract"). The Contract was awarded to Assignor.
- B. As required by the terms of the Contract and Idaho Code section 67-9230, Assignee requested the Purchasing Administrator approve assignment of the Contract from Assignor to Assignee.
- C. Assignee has informed Purchasing that it has purchased Assignor and has requested assignment.
- D. State is willing to approve Assignee's request subject to the terms of this Acceptance.

AGREEMENT

In consideration of the following representations, warranties, terms, conditions and covenants, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Contract remains in full force and effect in accordance with the Contract's terms except as specifically modified in this Acceptance. All of the terms herein shall have the same meaning as contained in the Contract, except as specifically defined otherwise in this Acceptance.
- 2. Assignee has consented in writing to the following term concerning service of process:

Contractor hereby consents to service of process upon it by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, at its last known address. Contractor must notify the State in writing of any change of address to which service of process can be made. Service shall be completed upon Contractor's actual receipt of process or upon the State's receipt of the return thereof by the United States Postal Service as refused or undeliverable. Contractor shall have thirty calendar days after completion of service in which to respond.
- 3. Unless waived in writing by Purchasing, Assignee shall possess financial qualifications and insurance equal to or better than those possessed by Assignor upon the effective date of the Contract. Additionally, Assignee shall provide equal or greater quality of products and shall provide an equal or greater level of customer service as was provided by Assignor since the effective date of the Contract.
- 4. Assignee shall be responsible and liable for all terms of the Contract. Assignee is liable for acts and omissions of Assignor prior to the effective date of the assignment.
- 5. The parties hereto do not intend that any persons or entities other than the parties hereto, and their successors and assigns, shall have any rights or remedies hereunder. The parties hereto specifically disclaim any intent to bestow any enforceable benefit upon any third parties as against the parties

hereto. Any benefit accruing to any such third party as the result of the execution of this Acceptance is merely coincidental and no third party may rely on receiving any such benefit.

6. This Acceptance shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with, the laws of Idaho without regard to its conflicts of law principles.
7. The Contract, as amended by this Acceptance constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements or understandings between the parties. The Contract may not be further amended in any manner except in a writing made and entered as set forth in the Contract or this Acceptance.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties have entered into this Acceptance effective as of the date of recognition by the Idaho Board of Examiners pursuant to Idaho Code section 67-1027.

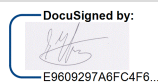
