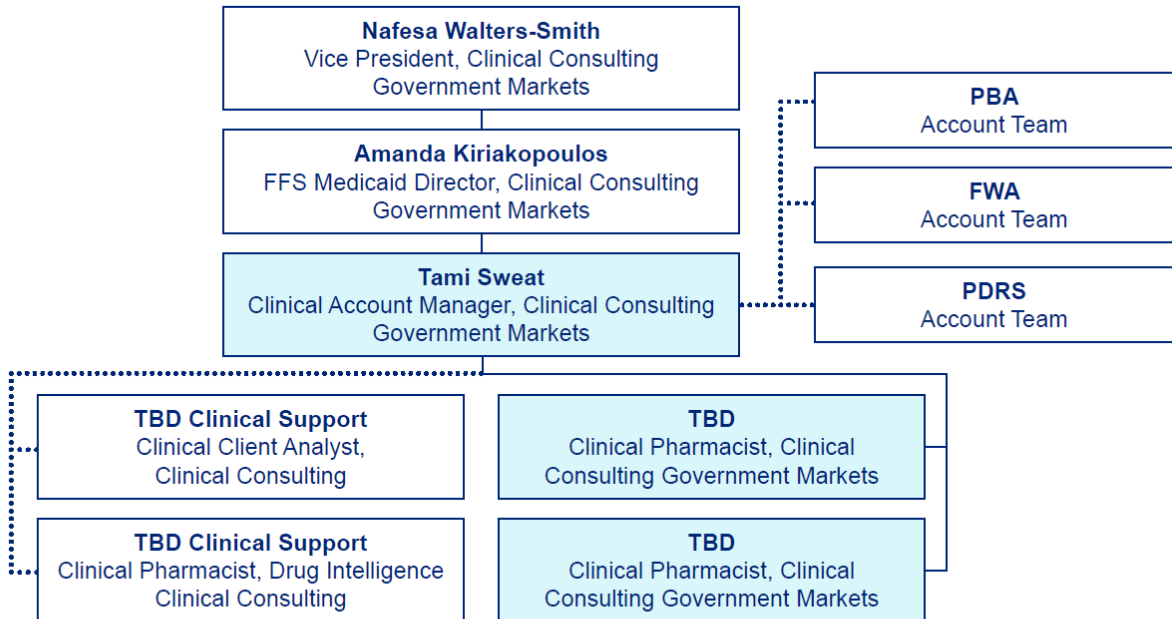


MSQ8,a - Optum Rx Organization Chart
