

PORTFOLIO TITLE: Debris Removal and Monitoring
LEAD STATE: State of Oklahoma

OVERVIEW:

The Multistate Sourcing Team led by the State of Oklahoma has completed the solicitation of the new NASPO ValuePoint portfolio for **Debris Removal and Monitoring Services**. The resulting Master Agreement awards will allow state and local governments to purchase services from Contractors who have been awarded through the NASPO ValuePoint cooperative.

INITIAL TERM: 2 Years

RENEWALS: Can exercise renewals totaling up to an additional five (5) years following the initial term, upon mutual agreement by the Lead State and Contractor.

TOTAL TERM POSSIBLE: 7 Years

NOTE: Purchasing Entities are encouraged to conduct a second round of competition by issuing a Request for Quotes (RFQ) to multiple awarded Contractors prior to selecting a Contractor for a specific project under this portfolio, identifying the Purchasing Entity's specific scope of work, operational requirements, timelines, and other project-specific needs. Soliciting competitive RFQs helps ensure the best overall value, promotes transparency and fairness, and allows Purchasing Entities to select the Contractor whose capabilities, capacity, pricing, and approach are best aligned with the unique requirements of the project.

SERVICE TYPES:

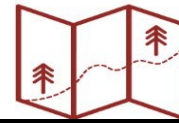
Debris Removal: Conduct debris removal operations per the terms of the contract and resulting statements of work in accordance with the state or entity Purchasing Agreement.

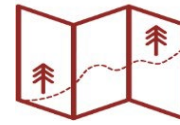

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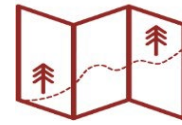
