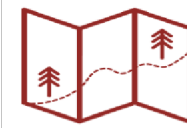

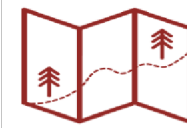

Final scoring was completed on April 2, 2025.

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EVALUATION CRITERIA:

Proposals that met or exceeded the Mandatory Minimum Requirements were evaluated against the following criteria:

SCORING:

Offeror's proposals were scored according to the RFP's Evaluation Criteria under Attachment C – RFP Evaluation Plan.

AWARD:

The RFP allowed for multiple vendor awards. The sourcing team recommended awards to four (4) suppliers across the eight (8) regions in alignment with the criteria set forth in the RFP.
