



11 major Bible doctrines

- The Bible and God (Father, Son, Spirit)— our source of everything
- 2 created beings Angels, Humans
- 2 spiritual states Sin, Salvation
- 2 peoples of God Israel, the Church
- The end times (future events)



- 1. The Bible is <u>meant</u> to be interpreted literally
- 2. God has two separate and distinct plans for the nation of Israel and for the church

Rules for interpreting prophecy

- 1. Interpret the passage literally
- 2. Compare prophecy with prophecy
- 3. Recognize possible time intervals
- 4. Recognize possible double references
- 5. Interpret figurative language Scripturally

1. Rapture – Jesus will collect the church to be with him

2. Judgment Seat of Christ – Christians will receive or lose rewards based on our faithfulness in this life

2 Corinthians 5:9-10

1 Corinthians 3:11-15

3. Tribulation – God will attack the world to purify Israel and punish Gentile nations; Satan will rule the world with special hatred toward all God's people

> Daniel 9:24–27 Revelation 6–18

4. Second Coming of Jesus – Jesus will rescue Israel, judge and destroy his enemies, and banish Satan

Revelation 19, 20:1-3 Zechariah 12-14

5. Millennial Kingdom – Jesus will rule as king from Jerusalem for 1,000 years and fulfill all outstanding promises to Israel

Revelation 20:4–10

Deuteronomy 30:1–10; 2 Samuel 7:6–16

Jeremiah 31:31–34; Ezekiel 36:24–38

6. Great White Throne Judgment – all unbelievers of all time will be judged and banished to the lake of fire


