A Report on
Two Months Medical Coding Course
Organized in Association with Symbiosis Institute

The major topics covered during the course included:

- CPT (Current Procedural Terminology)
- HCPCS Level II Coding
- Clinical / Research Coding
- Data Standards and Validation
- Quality, Safety, and Closeout
- Tools and Workflow in Research Context

- Case Studies and Practical Coding
- Soft Skills Development

After completing this program, the participants were able to:

- Accurately interpret medical records and clinical documentation for coding purposes.
- Apply ICD-10, CPT-4, and HCPCS coding systems effectively across various medical specialties.
- Demonstrate understanding of coding guidelines, conventions, and compliance standards.
- Prepare confidently for the CPC certification exam through structured practice and mock tests.
- Use coding software and tools to complete real-world coding assignments.
- Understand the healthcare reimbursement process and the role of coding in revenue cycle management.
- Increase their employability by gaining industry-relevant skills and certification readiness.

Our institute provided the necessary infrastructure facilities, including classrooms, seating arrangements, electricity, and other essential amenities for the smooth conduct of the program.
