



John W. Busterud, CSTJ, is Regional Administrator, United States Environmental Protection Agency, Pacific Southwest Region in San Francisco, California. John oversees federal environmental protection efforts in California, Arizona, Nevada, Hawaii, the Pacific territorial islands, and 148 federally recognized tribes.
