



Nasser J. Kazeminy, CSTJ, is a pioneering technology entrepreneur and innovator who was born in Iran, educated in England, and in 1969 was recruited by Control Data Corporation and relocated to the United States. In 1980 he established his own investment company, NJK Holding Corporation.
