The Learning Gardens Summer Groups Program is a Science-based experiential program that offers youth the opportunities to understand the importance of urban gardens through hands-on lessons in garden maintenance, games and fun science-based activities. Students practice horticultural techniques and learn concepts related to food justice and healthy eating. Groups of up to 25 students are invited to register for this 6-week program.

Each garden is staffed with a Program Manager who is college-educated and an experienced horticulturist and educator. The program incorporates a peer teaching model with our Learning Gardens Interns who are high school aged (or recent graduates).
