Traditional Security Product Solo vs. Traditional Product with ThreatFire

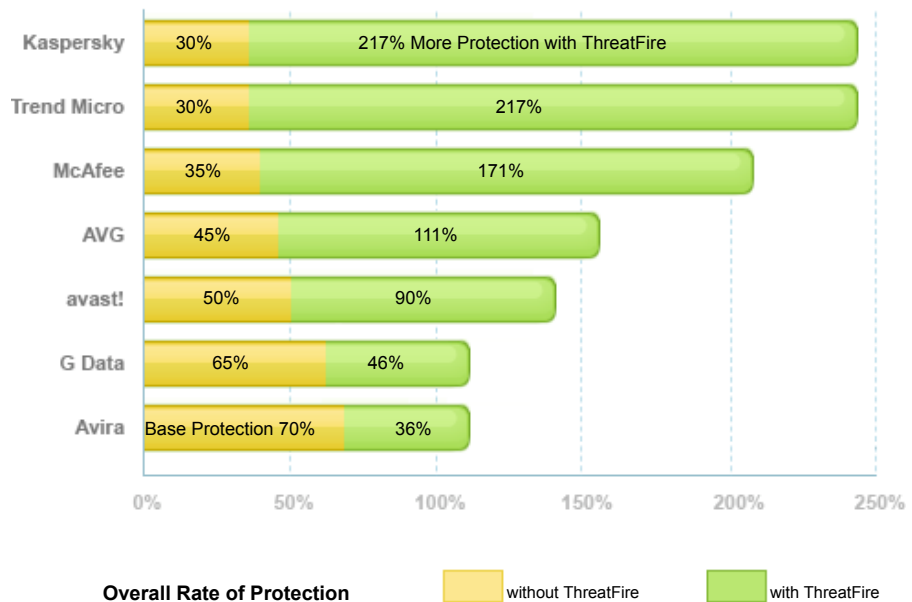

If I already have antivirus software why do I need ThreatFire?


