

**†The Confession of Faith** ....... The Heidelberg Catechism

- Why is the Son of God called "Jesus," meaning Q.29 "savior"?
- A. Because he saves us from our sins, and because salvation should not be sought and cannot be found in anyone else.
- Q.31 Why is he called "Christ," meaning "anointed"?
- 1563, the Heidelberg Catechism has been used by Christians around the world ever since. The Catechism summarizes the major teachings of Holy Scripture in one hundred and twenty-nine memorable questions and answers.

Corporate Confession of Sin (please kneel if able to do so)


Forgive our sins, O Lord.
