Q. 21 What is true faith?

A. True faith— created in me by the Holy Spirit through the gospel— Is not only a knowledge and conviction that everything that God reveals in his Word is true, But also a deep-rooted assurance that not only others, but I too, have had my sins forgiven, have been made right with God, and have been granted salvation.

Assurance of Pardoning Grace1 John 4:9-10
