Minutes

On motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the Executive Committee meetings of December 8, January 3, and January 11 and the Board of Directors meeting of November 16 were approved as previously mailed. pro.

Treasurer's Report

Mr. Larsen, Treasurer, reported as follows: pro.

At the close of the first seven months of the fiscal year, General Fund income amounted to \$57,904, or 37 per cent of annual budget, which is normal for this portion of the year, as most contributions are received after January. General Fund expenditures as of January 31 were \$70,849, or 54 per cent of budget. Seven months equal 58 per cent of budget.

The Restricted Funds, income has been received in accordance with budget schedule. Expenditures at the end of January amounted to \$352,168, or 62 per cent of budget.

Total expenditures for the first half were \$423,016, or 61 per cent of budget.

Mr. Norton reported on preliminary discussions with foundations and said that a prospectus is being discussed with the Executive Committee. Mr. Averill read a list of new and enlarged corporate subscriptions. Mr. Larsen said that unless new financing from foundations becomes available, the Association will have to change its operations substantially in the next fiscal year. He and Mr. Abramovitz urged members of the Board to assist Mr. Norton in the fund raising effort ahead.

Election of New Members

Mr. Norton presented a list of two hundred and four applicants for membership and one hundred forty-two dropped or resigned members for the period February 14, 1966 to January 31, 1967. The net increase in dues and subscriptions for the period was \$5,489. Mr. Norton said that this added sixty-two members net to the Association's rolls. The Board asked Mr. Averill to follow up on dropped members. pro.

On motion duly made and seconded, the listed resignations were accepted, the list of those deceased or dropped for non-payment of dues was approved and the list was ordered filed with these minutes.

Acceptance of Mr. Wakeman's Resignation

Mr. Norton said that Mr. Howard Wakeman had submitted his resignation as a member of the Board of Directors. He said that Mr. Wakeman would be missed. The Board accepted the resignation regretfully and asked that an appropriate letter be sent to Mr. Wakeman. pro.

"The Region's Growth" Report

Mr. Tankel described the Association's forthcoming Second Regional Plan staff report entitled, "The Region's Growth." He said that the volume sets forth the basic employment and population projections upon which the rest of RPA's planning is predicated. The growth of the Region, he said, is set within the context of the greater urban region along the Atlantic Urban Seaboard and the growth of population and metropolitan areas throughout the world. pol.

In the discussion, Mr. Tankel was asked to be sure that the new counties added to RPA's Study Area for the Second Regional Plan be apprised of this impending report affecting their interests.

Mr. Norton observed that the only policy position in the report is a recommendation calling for a large-scale reservation of open space. The following resolution was introduced and accepted:

Resolved that RPA endorse the broad concept that the best development of urban settlement along the Atlantic Urban Seaboard from Washington, D. C. to Boston to the year 2000 calls for a continuing policy of acquiring a great system of public parks in the Appalachian Mountains from Virginia to Vermont, a great system of public ocean beaches from the Virginia Capes to Cape Ann and extensive public open space reservations where appropriate along the Seaboard's great rivers: Potomac, Susquehanna, Delaware, Hudson, Housatonic and Connecticut.

Proposed statement on "Aviation in the New York Metropolitan Region"

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Mr. Norton reminded the Board that a statement, "Aviation in the New York Metropolitan Region," as prepared by the staff with recommended changes by the Executive Committee had been mailed out for review by members of the Board prior to this meeting. Board members unable to attend were invited to telephone comments. Mr. Norton said that comments favoring the statement had been received from Board members Gross, Bound, Sayre, Yunich and Gulick who were unable to attend this meeting.

Mr. Norton said the statement was based in large part on two reports: a March 1965 publication by Tri-State Transportation Commission on General Aviation, Airports for the Future; the other, Airport Requirements and Sites to Serve the New Jersey-New York Metropolitan Region published in December 1966 by the Port of New York Authority.

RPA's proposed statement, Mr. Norton said, points out the mounting public concern over the potential danger of accidents owing to congestion at the Region's three major airports. It emphasizes that 98 per cent of the passengers at the Region's three major airports are carried by the scheduled commercial airlines. The balance are carried in non-airline aircraft (general aviation, including air taxis and private aircraft). General aviation aircraft carry one-and-a-half passengers per plane on the average; they do not need 12,000 foot runways or large passenger terminals and while they carry only 2 per cent of the total passengers they occupy 20 per cent of takeoff and landing time.

The Port Authority report establishes that the capacity of the Region's three major airports would be sufficient to handle the estimated increased air passenger traffic until 1980, if general aviation aircraft were eliminated during the crucial rush hours under instrument flight conditions. This is principally because the expected increase in air passengers will be handled in new airliners now in production capable of handling 2 1/2 times present average airplane passenger loads.

At the same time that the Port Authority's report has underscored the importance of general aviation to the airport problem, Tri-State's report recommends a system of separate general aviation airports, many in operation now, and capable of rapid expansion at a cost of \$38 million, plus perhaps another \$20 million for ground facilities. This figure should be compared to the \$600 million cost of a fourth major airport as proposed by the Port of New York Authority.

The Port Authority's latest report finds for the second time that the only site they can recommend for a fourth major airport is in the Great Swamp in Morris County (northern New Jersey), an area which is not likely to be available for airport development. Large sections are now a conservation area administered by the Interior Department. Furthermore, the Port Authority states that any new major airport could not be in operation until 1975.

Thus, the next all-new major airport for the Region is still eight years and at least one major airport report away. In the meantime, an improved general aviation airport system is within immediate reach and is less expensive. To develop a general aviation airport system now would alleviate present and potentially increasing flight hazards promptly, give the Region time to plan for the next major airport, and improve airport service for the important (though numerically few) general aviation passengers.

If the statement mailed to the Board is approved, Mr. Norton concluded, RPA would urge that the governors of the three states (1) progress the development of a general airport system capable of handling the growing needs of non-commercial aircraft, (2) order a new and much broader study of the need for and location of a fourth airport in the light of technological developments listed in the staff statement, including the supersonic plane.

The following points were covered in the discussion which ensued: (1) Safety demands that a citizen organization speak out when airport congestion is growing increasingly dangerous. It was recommended that RPA's statement refer to the "potential hazard." (2) We have faced up to the need of restricting use of the automobile in the overly-congested Manhattan central business district, and we now face the same question of impinging on private rights for the public good with general aviation (business and pleasure flying). (3) A distinction can be made between general aviation flights like air taxis connecting with commercial airliners and other private aircraft movements. For example, many general aviation aircraft are based at LaGuardia. (4) The possibility of naming McGuire Air Force Base as the likeliest location for a fourth major airport was considered and rejected until a study of several potential sites is made. Calvertan, McGuire, Stewart and Solberg-Hunterdon were considered possibilities. Mr. Brown said that the air corridors in relation to McGuire are not inflexible as intimated by the Federal Aviation Agency and Port of New York Authority. They can be altered if necessary, he said.

The statement was adopted unanimously and Messrs. Binger and Brown were asked to review the modifications to be made by the staff to see that they conform to the Board's suggestions.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:15 p.m.
