Attached is an analysis of data compiled by Regional Plan Association to investigate the relationship of jobs, skills and housing locations in the New York Urban Region. The data were compiled as input to a study by the National Committee against Discrimination in Housing (NCDH) under a grant from the Carnegie Corporation. The NCDH study will be released concurrently.

A press briefing on the attached report and on the NCDH study will be held at 11 a.m., Tuesday, February 29, 1972, at the offices of the National Committee against Discrimination in Housing, 1865 Broadway, 10th Floor, Manhattan.
