At the time we announced the appropriation of half the salary of your Rosenwald Building Agent last Spring it was stated that the Fund expected to cut this amount in half for the year 1928-29. Dear Mr. Smith:

We have finally been able to secure the services of Prof. Vincent Harris of Brunswick, Georgia, for Rosenwald Building Agent. He was recommended by Mr. Hill before he (Walter) left during the early fall but was unable to arrange his affairs in Brunswick so that he could be released until just recently. He went to work Saturday, November 15th, and will do part-time work until December 5th, after which time he will be on the job as a full-time worker.

Prof. Harris is an exceptional man in some respects - particularly so far as his technical training for this work is concerned. He is one of the few vocational men who is a practical builder. He has taught at Savannah, at Fort Valley, and at Forsyth and should have a very wide acquaintance. I believe he is going to make us a good man and Mr. Hill, who knew him better than I do, felt the same way about it - in fact, so much so that he recommended Harris for the position before leaving.

I wish that I could be with you at your dedication of the five thousandth Rosenwald school in Virginia next Friday but am afraid that I am going to be unable to attend.
