While he was a student we were able to open the way for him to receive during two summers some valuable experience at our local public hospital.

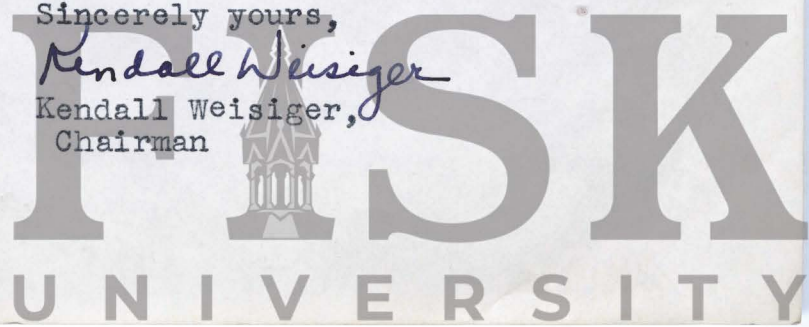
As you will see in the report he is doing most of the surgery, although he has not had all the training for it that he should have.
