Dear Dean Cater: I see no reason why a student who wished to study personnel or to do work in accountancy could not come under our scholarship aid program. The main thing to keep in mind is that the same general limitations which apply to regular fellowships apply to these scholarship aid grants. That is, a person who wishes to work toward an initial professional degree or toward a bachelor's degree (B. S. in library science, for example) is not eligible for a scholarship aid grant.
