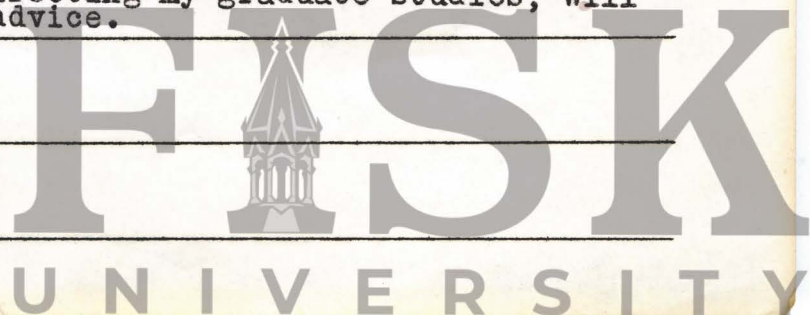
Concise statement of plan of work I plan to carry on research in Southern History and to write a doctoral dissertation on "A History of Penal Reforms in the South Since the Civil War".

Institution you wish to attend My research will be carried on from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, N.C.

Under whose supervision will you work? Dr. Fletcher M. Green, Professor of American History.

Will any time be spent in field work? If so, how much, and where? I shall need to spend several weeks at the Massachusetts State Library, the Harvard Law Library, and the Library of Congress; and I plan to visit the penitentiaries of the Southern states in order to examine prison records, talk to prison officials, and see at first hand what is being done for the prison population. I believe that I shall need three months in the field.

If you do not plan to have an institutional connection, how do you propose to spend your time? The main part of my work will be done at the University of North Carolina, and Dr. Fletcher M. Green, who is directing my graduate studies, will direct my research and give me his advice.



For what period are you requesting a renewal? From September, 1945, to
September, 1946.

Present status of work toward your degree With the end of this semester,
I shall have completed the course requirements in my minor.
By June, I shall have completed all of the course requirements
and shall take my preliminary and written examinations in the
summer. That will leave me a full year to carry on my research
project and to finish the dissertation.
I hope to receive the Ph.D. in the summer of 1946.
