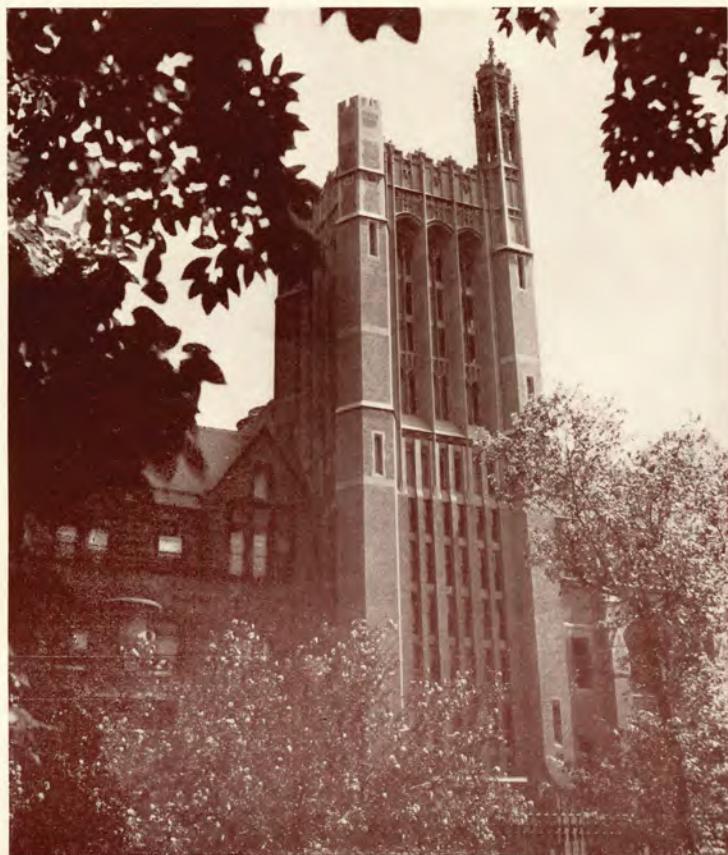

SCHOLARSHIPS OF THE ADVANCED SCHOOL OF EDUCATION

- Number of scholarships available.....5 to 7
- Basic amount of each scholarship.....\$1200

This will be increased for a married man accompanied by his family in the amount of \$500 for his wife and \$150 for each child. Maximum allowance will be \$2000.

- Who may apply: Persons who are or who expect to become candidates for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy or Doctor of Education in Teachers College.
- Preference will be given to persons under thirty-five years of age.

FELLOWSHIPS AND SCHOLARSHIPS NOT LIMITED TO ADVANCED SCHOOL STUDENTS

- Number of awards available.....10
- Amount of awards.....\$250 to \$1000
- Who may apply:
 - Persons with a Bachelor's degree or beyond.
 - Persons who will have a Bachelor's degree by August 31, 1939.

RESEARCH AND TEACHING ASSISTANTSHIPS

- Number of assistantships available.....20
- Amount of each assistantship.....\$250 to \$1000
- Who are eligible for assistantships: All applicants for fellowships and scholarships unless they have indicated that their interest is only in the fellowships and scholarships.
- Factors considered in preparing a list of those eligible for assistantships:
 - The abilities of the applicant.
 - The contribution to the applicant's preparation which the assistantship will make.

BASIS OF AWARDS

- Information submitted with the application form. Applicants are not required to duplicate information already on file in the Advanced School office.
- Information obtained from personal interviews.
- Competitive examinations:
 - Examination covering abstract verbal ability.
 - Examination in a field to be chosen by the candidate.

OTHER INFORMATION

Awards are not limited to any particular field of specialization in Teachers College. To apply for these awards a person need not have attended Teachers College previously. Application blanks and other information will be supplied on request by the Committee on Fellowships and Scholarships, Teachers College, Columbia University, New York City. The applications must be postmarked not later than midnight, February 1, 1939. The examinations will be held on March 10 and 11, 1939, at 54 convenient centers in the United States and foreign lands. Announcement of the awards will be made on or about April 15,

1939. Additional details can be found in the Teachers College Announcement and the Bulletin of the Advanced School of Education obtainable from the Secretary of Teachers College. The Loan Fund Board has funds available to assist outstanding students. These loans may be used to supplement savings and other funds at the disposal of the student for his study at Teachers College. Students wishing to make application for loans should address the Chairman of the Loan Fund Board. In general, however, it is well to utilize local sources of loan funds wherever possible.
