Dear Dr. Johnson: Dr. Dibble has sent me copy of a letter which you forwarded to him regarding your scholarship application with the Julius Rosenwald Fund.

I regret that I am not able to give you a definite answer at this time. At the recent meeting of the Board of Trustees, the matter of future programs for the Rosenwald Fund was given serious consideration, ending with a demand for greater concentration of our efforts.

I should like you to feel that we maintain a great interest in the possibilities of your work. When some plans with reference to the entire set-up at Tuskegee are more definite, serious and immediate consideration will be given to your application. At that time we will be in a better position definitely to determine what the future holds for a man with your training.
