Rosenwald Fellowship, 1937-38, \$1000.

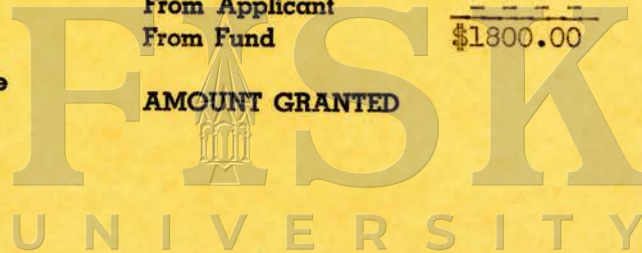
