7. In accepting aid from the Julius Rosenwald Fund—one-half cost first year, one-third second year, and one-fourth the third year, up to fixed maximums—the public school authorities agree to continue the service after the third year without further aid.

(Aid for new transportation in 1930-31 was limited to one consolidated school of three-teacher type or larger in a county, or to one high school in a county, with a school term of at least eight months and no teacher's salary less than \$60 a month, preference given to new or recent consolidations where at least two years of high school work is provided and all teachers meet state or county requirements as to certification. Wherever aid is given either in the purchase or in the operation of a school transportation bus, it must be of modern type, meeting reasonable specifications for safety and comfort of pupils).

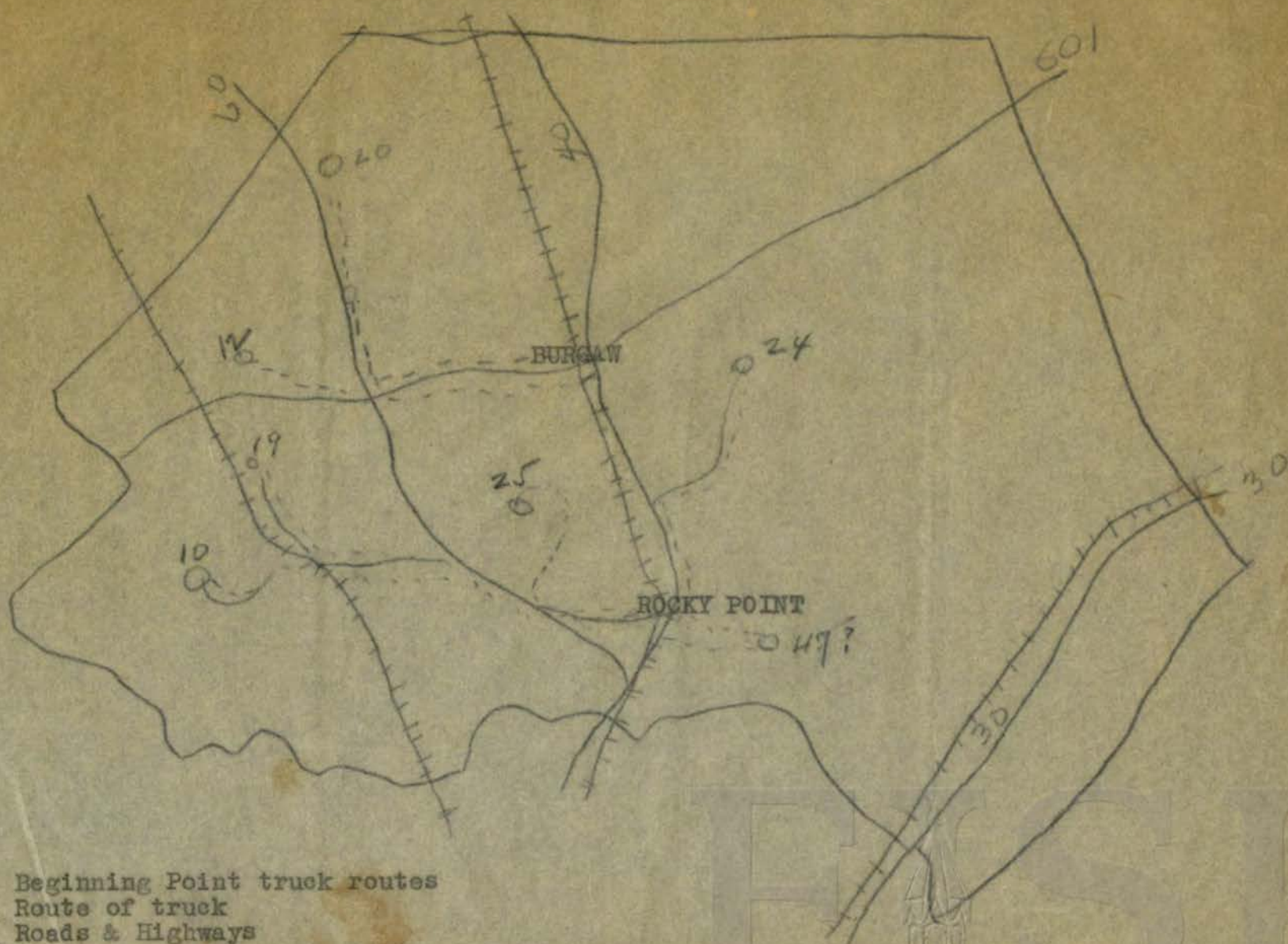
