Dear Miss Utley-

Thank you for your gracious letter which reached me today. For a long time I have wanted to tell you how nice you are so let just do it now! I do appreciate the friendly interest and concern which you have always shown.

I am sorry to have been so slow in sending in the report but life has been rather complicated. I have written in the title and address on the form. The study is called a "Survey of the Higher Education of Negroes." My responsibility is that of a socio-economic study to determine needs.

I am sorry to say that the thesis is still unfinished as I have been able to do almost no work in a full year. I accepted this position only on condition that I have time off to finish the writing - the material is all collected and about half the writing is done. I am to be on half time from January to July in which period I expect to complete the work. All other requirements for the degree have been met.

Thank you for sending the books and pamphlets. We have a big job ahead of us and we need all the help possible.
