The car was en route from Branbridge, Ontario, to the Muskoka Lakes Country Club, Ontario. The accident took place about 1/2 mile outside of Port Carling on the country club side. I received your letter regarding the car and shall expect you after June 7.

On Friday, May 26, I had an accident while driving the car near the intersection of two downtown streets. A white gentleman, Mr. H. F. Williams of 555 Western Avenue Atlanta, and I were approaching the corner as the red light came on. We were both driving in the lane next to the curb. I looked

behind me and he was still in the same lane. As I swung over into the middle lane he attempted to pass me without blowing his horn. He was traveling faster than I but before he could pass, my front bumper and front left fender collided with his rear right fender. As a result his fender and mine were damaged. The damage in either case was not serious.





In addition to these repairs, I should like to have you fix the electrical connection on the starter button which fails to operate at times, and the electrical connection on the dash light which blinks when going over rough roads. Also, there continues to be a leak in the water line somewhere. I have noticed after the car stands for some time a pool of water immediately under the radiator, but I have been unable to locate the leak.






