Dear Mr. Elder: The enclosed legal notice was sent us from the Atlanta Biltmore Hotel. We regret not knowing that we are liable for a city tax imposed by the city of Atlanta. The car referred to in the notice was kept in an Atlanta garage during the early months of 1938, from where it was used occasionally by officers of the Julius Rosenwald Fund for the promotion of philanthropy in the South. This car was driven to the city of Chicago in June, 1938, and sold the following November. To replace this car, the Julius Rosenwald Fund purchased a 1938 tudor Ford sedan, license No. 66169-D, in November. It was driven to Georgia in the same month. It is registered in my name, but should be registered in the name of the Fund. This change will be made upon application for the 1940 license.

If you will send necessary documents and information regarding the city taxes on these cars to Miss Dorothy Elvidge, comptroller of the Fund, she will take care of this matter.
