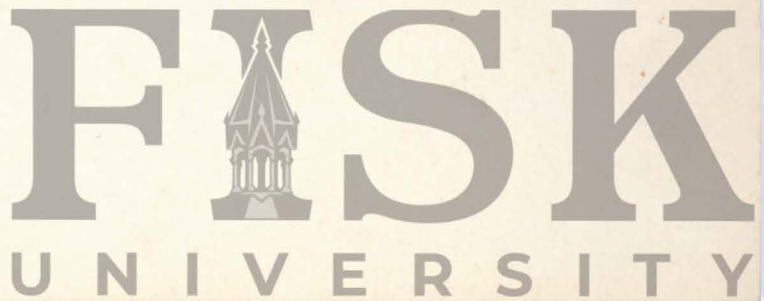
To work toward Master's degree at Atlanta University.
