Dear Miss Atkins: The Committee on Fellowships of the Julius Rosenwald Fund has had its final meeting, and from more than fifty applications for scholarship aid has made eighteen awards. It is with genuine regret that I must tell you the Committee did not find it possible to grant your request at this time. I am sure you appreciate, however, that your case was reviewed with the utmost thought and care, and that the Committee's action in nowise represents a lack of interest in you or in your plans for your career. I hope that other means will be found to enable you to begin your graduate study.

I am enclosing an information sheet about our senior fellowship program, which may be of interest to you in the future.
