Dear Dr. Bousfield,

Received your letter of January 16, 1940,  
 and I understand fully that it is not possible to  
 secure a scholarship at this time. However, I wish  
 to state my problem to you again. I'm not applying  
 for a residency at Freedman's Hospital. I've just  
 finished three years at the Hospital in Baltimore  
 as resident surgeon (one year of this as assistant).  
 It has been arranged with the surgical faculty  
 of Howard to take me on as a fellow in surgery.  
 and your scholarship would be toward that end.  
 In our previous correspondence your question  
 was "where would you do this work in surgery".  
 I had not then made any specific arrangements  
 and could not answer definitely. Then I was told  
 no funds would be available until July 1940.
