Dear Dr. Smillie: On January 27 you were kind enough to send to Mr. Embree a recommendation for Dr. W. B. Perry, Jr., one of your colored students in the Harvard School of Public Health. I am very happy to have this letter, and I think that we may be able to find a place for Dr. Perry.

The Julius Rosenwald Fund is at present interested in establishing health centers in Negro neighborhoods under the direction of competent Negro administrators. We are not yet certain how rapidly nor how well such a program can be developed, but certainly there is considerable interest in it. If the program goes over well, there will be need of additional well-trained Negro physicians.
