Dear Doctor Boswell: Your note of July 29 has been referred to me since Doctor McLean is already out of the city. When the grant was made to you in January 1940, it was very carefully considered and was awarded with the understanding that this grant would enable you to complete the course and prepare you for the American board. While we recognize that conditions over which you have no control have affected the requirements, I am afraid our group would feel that it had already contributed its proper quota to your preparation. I hope by some other means you may find it possible to complete your work. If this is not possible without further help, I suggest that you present the matter to us again in September when Doctor McLean will be back. I think it fair to say, however, that at most I believe we will be willing to consider any further help only at a minimum level distinctly below the rate at which we have been helping during the past twenty months.

We are interested in your preparation, but I am sure you will realize the difficulty that any such board as this finds in continuing grants beyond the period originally designated.

Dear Dr. McLean:

I am writing to request an extension or renewal of the Rosenwald Fellowship which I hold and which expires in September of this year.

In January, 1940 I was granted a fellowship with which to study dermatology and syphilology preparatory to taking the American board in that field. The stipend was for a twenty-month period in order to complete the two years that had been started. Since then the requirements have been advanced to a three-year minimum of supervised training, and I am now applying for funds for additional training.

My work was started under the supervision of Dr. S. A. Becker of the University of Chicago and Dr. H. W. Thatcher who was associated at Billings Clinic and head of the department at Provident Hospital. I am also working with Dr. T. K. Lawless.

Because of changes in both Dr. Becker's and Dr. Thatcher's affiliations, all of my supervised work is now being done under Dr. T. K. Lawless and at Provident Hospital. I am still of military age, but was rejected on physical examination last month. Therefore, I anticipate being able to complete any work that I start.

Any additional information concerning my work can be obtained either from Provident Hospital, the Rosenwald Foundation or Dr. Lawless. I need not tell you how anxious I am that this application will meet your approval. Thank you for your consideration.

Dear Sir:

I am making application for a fellowship as suggested in our conversation this morning. Briefly, I am 33 years old and married. My medical work was done at the University of Minnesota, where I also did some graduate work in pathology. I took a Bachelor of Medicine degree in 1939 and the Doctor of Medicine Degree in 1940 after completing a year's internship at Provident Hospital, Chicago, Illinois.

Since then, I have begun postgraduate work in the field of dermatology and syphilology under Drs. R. Scull and T. K. Lawless separately. My work at Provident Hospital clinics under Dr. Scull embraces chiefly syphilology. With Dr. Lawless in his private practice emphasis is on dermatology. Both men are members of their specialty board, The American Board of Dermatology and Syphilology, and are excellent teachers. I feel that the training opportunity is unique.

My hope is that I may qualify for the specialty board after two years study, four months of which I have already completed. To be able to do that, I sorely need financial assistance. Receipt of one of your \$1500 fellowships will assure my tenure of training for an additional twenty months. This will qualify me for examination by the American Board of Dermatology and Syphilology.

I am entirely satisfied with the agreement to establish myself in the South, specifically in Durham, North Carolina.

I cannot adequately express my appreciation of the consideration you have shown me - please know that this appreciation is deep and sincere. May I expect an early and favorable reply?

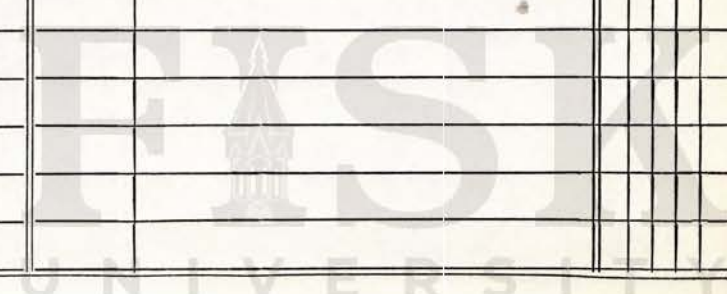
