My dear Dr. Bousfield:-

Your letter of February 7th addressed to Dr. Jesse G. M. Bullowa, was referred to me.

I do not know whether all the facts in the matter of the application for Fellowship for Dr. Ernest C. Holder have been presented to you. I am writing you, therefore, to present these facts.

Dr. Holder has been Resident in Pathology at this Hospital for a period of two and one-half years, during which time he has given excellent service and shown an earnest effort and ability to grasp the knowledge in Pathology.

In my effort to secure further training for him in the field of Pathology, I have been able to obtain for him a Fellowship with Dr. Klemperer, Pathologist at the Mount Sinai Hospital, New York City, for a period of one year beginning July 1st, 1935. Unfortunately, however, this Fellowship does not include maintenance or any remuneration. Dr. Holder has no funds to carry him through this Fellowship. It is necessary, therefore, that he secure financial aid during the period of his stay at the Mount Sinai Hospital.

It is the purpose in making application to your fund, to secure the above aid.

I am very much concerned in furthering the interests of Dr. Holder and I feel sure that any aid granted him by your fund will be amply compensated in the training of a Pathologist of the colored race.
