My plan of work embraces an expenditure of approximately twelve months, beginning July 1, 1940, at Teachers College, Columbia University, working in connection with staff members of the University and with officials of the Commission on Teacher Education of the American Council on Education on problems in Teacher Education, stemming from the development of a "Community School" at Norris. Such a study would have implications in Teacher Education for the country at large and the South in particular.
