Dear Mr. Woodward: In response to the application in your letter of April 9, I beg to inform you that fellowships have been awarded by the Julius Rosenwald Fund as follows:

To Mr. M. W. Shock, a research fellowship of \$2,500 for the year 1930-31 for studies in physiology and biochemistry, with the understanding that his chief responsibility will be to these departments, though his work may include questions of psychological reactions.

To Dr. Frank Alexander, a fellowship of \$3,000 to enable him to serve as visiting Professor of Abnormal Psychology or Psychiatry in the Department of Medicine.

We are granting these fellowships because of our interest in developing personnel at the University of Chicago in the mental sciences with special reference to human behavior.
