You will, I know, be glad to see that we were able to renew his fellowship in the full amount requested - \$2,000. It was possible to do this from funds released by Mr. William Henry Dean who wrote us soon after the final meeting that since he could not for some time use the grant made to him last year for study abroad he felt he should relinquish the \$2,500.

I hope that your busy time is over for a little while, and that you can catch up with yourself.
