Obtained B. A. from Lincoln University, Pennsylvania, 1921. Attended YMCA College, Chicago, 1922-24; obtained B.S.E. from Langston University, 1925. Has attended University of Cincinnati during summer sessions of 1924-25-26-27.

1926-27 principal of Rosenwald High, Harlan, Kentucky, \$155 month; Membership Secretary, 1927, Carlton Avenue YMCA, Brooklyn, \$160 month; teacher in Louisville, Kentucky, 1927, \$160 month; director State YMCA 1929 to present, \$100 month and expenses.

Creative and research work: At present a study of socio-economic status of the Kentucky Negro is being made by the Kentucky Commission on Interracial Cooperation, under Bond's direction. He created the Kentucky Plan, which brings the YMCA program to all rural and urban centers of the state. Regular contributor to the "Point of View Column" of the Louisville Courier Journal under caption of "Interracially Speaking." Also a weekly article under same title in the Louisville Defender.
