Dear Dag: You will remember that you suggested when I got my A ration book that if I wanted to get more gas than the minimum I might apply on a form to the ration board. At that time I hadn't contemplated a greater need than the 16 gallons a month, chiefly because I went into Alabama as often as I drove around Atlanta. It seems now, however, that I misjudged. Also, the pending extension of the ration area to include Alabama pretty nearly makes it imperative that we get more gas. How would you instruct me to go about it? If you sent me an application blank, I have lost it. Could you send another, and the address of the person to whom I should apply, and the sort of justification I would need. I would ask for an increase on the grounds of considerable rural travel that would be difficult if not impossible by bus, and travel concentrated in the space of a few days.

I would like to ask for an S card and use whatever is necessary. Some months there would be no extra over the A ration and some months there might be more. Do you think there might be a possibility that the board would make such a grant? I'd appreciate it if I could hear from you soon because I would like to get it settled before the first of November.

Dear Sir: Attached is an application for a supplemental gasoline ration book to be used for the purchase of gasoline in connection with the work of the Julius Rosenwald Fund.

You will note that on July 22, 1942, your board issued an A ration book for a Dodge car licensed in Georgia and owned by the Julius Rosenwald Fund. This car is driven in Georgia and the neighboring states exclusively in connection with the work of the Rosenwald Fund. It is used only by employees of this Fund. Sometimes two or more employees have occasion to make a trip together. The car is seldom used by only one individual.

For the most part the car is used to travel in rural areas visiting such centers as West Georgia College, Fort Valley State College, the University of Georgia, educational centers in Alabama, and the rural schools of such counties as Carroll, Greene, Macon, Bibb in Georgia, and Macon County, Alabama. Such visits have to be made periodically and within a period of time that would make bus or train travel difficult if not impossible. Furthermore, a large part of the travel is made to rural centers not served by public conveyance.

The officers of the Julius Rosenwald Fund would appreciate it if your board would review this application for supplemental gasoline for the current period.

If, on the other hand, Porter returns from Columbus and finds that the proposed work during the winter quarter sounds good and <sup>you</sup> will wish to make a substitution for Mary, I am in agreement.

I think your idea for a recruiting campaign is good. I am sure it will have results. It really should have been done long ago, although I know you did a great deal. It will have added benefits, one of them, I think, being that others beside Mr. Gunn will be interpreting the program of work at West Georgia.

Perhaps you have seen the small manuscript that Eve has banged off. It looks pretty swell to me. I have sent a copy to Mary and Mike with the suggestion that Mary might draw some small illustrations for it. I am hoping that we can get several copies out before Christmas.

Dear Mr. Williams: I had hoped I might be able to talk with you before I left Atlanta and leave with you a request to get a few things done to the Dodge. Since this was not possible, I am writing to you with the hope that you might be able to put it in the shop as soon as possible and ask the mechanics to give it a thorough checking. These things I know need to be worked on:

- 1) The top hose connection from the radiator to the head of the block is leaking. I fancy it will need a new hose.
- 2) I have reason to believe that water has been running from the radiator into the crankcase and that oil has been getting out into the radiator. I think there must be a broken gasket that will need replacing.
- 3) There was something wrong with it when I started. I can't name the part that I think needs fixing, but this is the symptom: After the car has been sitting for several days, it will not start. Only by pouring gasoline into it will it begin to respond. It needs a new something-or-other, the name of which has slipped me, but I am sure the mechanic will know what I am talking about.
- 4) I would like to get the spark plugs cleaned, and those that need it, replaced. The timer should be checked, and the motor generally tuned up.
- 5) Please also have it greased. I think it has been some time since that was done.

I would appreciate it very much if you would have this attended to as soon as possible. I expect to be down again the latter part of this month and would like to use the car at that time. In its present condition, it ought not to be taken any farther than from the garage to the shop.
