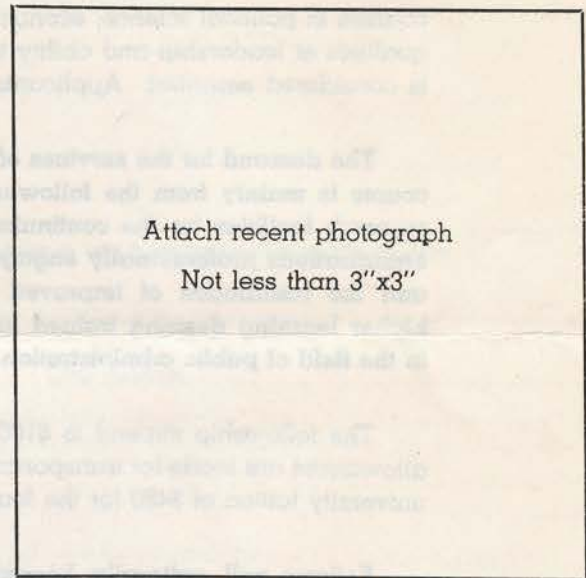

**NOTE: Applicants should carefully read the following before mailing application:**

To be eligible for a fellowship the candidate must have, upon admission, at least a bachelor's degree. His preparation should preferably have included courses in political science, economics, accounting, and statistics. Evidence of qualities of leadership and ability to meet people, as well as high scholarship, is considered essential. Applicants should be under thirty-five years of age.

**The demand for the services of graduates of the government management course is mainly from the following sources: (1) civic associations requiring research facilities for the continuing appraisal of their local governments; (2) organizations professionally engaged in the survey of governmental agencies and the installation of improved administrative systems; (3) institutions of higher learning desiring trained faculty personnel for teaching and research in the field of public administration.**

The fellowship stipend is \$100 per month for twelve months. Additional allowances are made for transportation expense incurred in field work. Regular university tuition of \$480 for the four-quarter program will be charged.

**Fellows will ordinarily become candidates for the degree of Master of Science in Government Management at the University of Denver. In appropriate cases the candidate may work out a cooperative arrangement for the doctorate from the institution under which he has already pursued his graduate work.**
