In response to your request for a statement of my opinion of the abilities and personal characteristics of Miss Juanita Vivian Gregory, who has applied to your foundation for a scholarship to secure further training in public health nursing, I am submitting the following:

I have known Miss Gregory about twelve years and have observed her work in the field of private and public health nursing. About ten years ago we secured an opportunity for a colored nurse to be taken on the City nursing staff. Because of the splendid reputation, excellent training, high moral character and pleasing personality of Miss Gregory, we recommended her for the position which she secured. The manner in which she has departed herself on the job has fully justified our action in the matter. As a result of the efficiency with which she discharged her duties, and because of her excellent spirit and ability and willingness to work with people, three additional colored nurses have been taken on the staff of the City Health Department.

The district in which Miss Gregory works contains a large number of clients of this organization. This fact has brought us in close contact with her and with her work, as well as our close association on committees handling public health problems.

I would unhesitatingly commend Miss Gregory to you as a young woman in every way deserving favorable consideration for the scholarship for which she is applying.
