Your letter of June 13 to Mr. John Holmes has been referred to this office for answering.

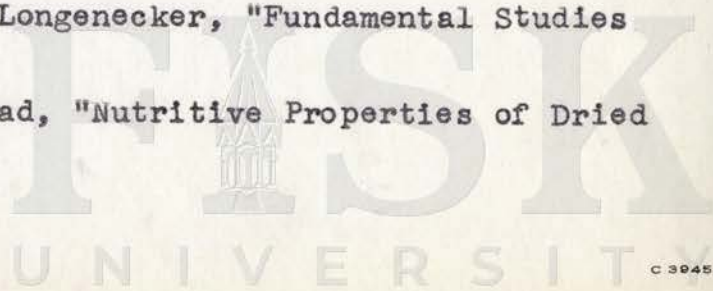
We believe that we have two categories of prizes and scholarships for students or research workers which probably fit in with the type of information which you are attempting to develop. These two categories are:

1. Prizes and scholarships administered by the Agricultural Research Department of Swift & Company and which include (pamphlets attached):
 - (a) Scholarships to 4-H Club members for poultry achievement.
 - (b) Prizes to high school students for essays on marketing methods employed by the packing business for meats, butter, poultry, eggs, and cheese.
 - (c) Awards to college students for essays on marketing methods employed by the packing business for meats, butter, poultry, eggs, and cheese.
2. Distribution of funds appropriated by the Board of Directors of the Company to colleges and universities for grants-in-aid and fellowships.

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
