Dear Dr. Gibson: I am sending you copy of a letter which I have received from Dr. Charles M. Griffith, Medical Director of the Veterans Administration. I am sure that if you desire to give any further consideration to my suggestions that you will have to go through the steps with Dr. Griffith points out in his letter. I have absolutely no authority for suggesting that I can be of any assistance to you in getting an appointment, and I am sure that Dr. Griffith would be entirely too smart to write a letter which would be anything other than the copy I have enclosed. On the other hand, I know very well that there are opportunities for additional appointments at Tuskegee. I would suggest that if you continue an interest in this type of work you should follow the directions in this letter and attempt to qualify through either civil service or executive order for an appointment.
