

PLAN OF WORK

It is my desire to help improve the standards and service of the Nursing Profession here where I am located. This can be done by advanced study in Nursing Education, which, is divided into Major and Minor fields.

These include briefly: Ward Management, Ward Teaching, Present Objectives in Nursing Education and Nursing Service, How to set up Criteria and apply them in evaluating Typical Nursing Curricula, the Modern School of Nursing, Goals of Teaching and Learning, Community, State and National Responsibilities for the care of Patients and for advancing the interest of the Nursing Profession.

In order to meet the requirements in the rapidly advancing profession, better trained nurses must be stressed. Nurses who can cope with any situation must be produced.
