

FELLOWSHIP COMMITTEE MEETING NOTES - 1947

Unused Balances of Grants

ALFRED BRYAN BONDS, JR: Letter March 28, 1944, written by Mrs. Maygood saying balance of \$1350 would be held until discharged from the Navy. Letter June 24, 1946 from Bonds saying he would resume full-time work during summer of 1947. Letter March 31, 1947 by WCH inquiring whether grant will be taken up or not.

FREDERICK DOUGLAS JENKINS: Jenkins has gone into business in Los Angeles. WCH wrote letter March 31, 1947 inquiring whether grant will be used.

JOHN WILLIAM LIPSCOMB: Applying 1947. Still has \$125 remaining from war interrupted fellowship grant. This amount could be applied against the \$800 which Lipscomb is now requesting. WCH wrote him on March 11, 1943, saying that \$125 balance would be held in his name.

JOHN NEWTON LYLE: Letter written by Miss Elvidge, February 1945, said balance would be held in his name. Letter to Lyle, April 17, 1946 by WCH, neither answered nor returned unclaimed. Letter WCH, March 31, 1947 setting termination date of June 30, 1947.

HENRY A. PAGE, III: WCH letter April 17, 1946, neither answered nor returned unclaimed. Letter March 28, 1947 setting termination date of June 30, 1947.

MARK HANNA WATKINS: Folder to be at meeting.

LEROY WATSON, JR: WCH letter April 17, 1946, neither answered nor returned unclaimed. Letter March 28, 1947 setting termination date of June 30, 1947.
