My dear Mr. Embree:

You were kind enough to agree to invest \$2,000 in the study of Negro participation in social control, and in 1933 you advanced \$500 on this amount.

We have had Charles S. Johnson, a group at the University of North Carolina, and a group here in Atlanta doing preliminary work in order that we might arrive at a method of procedure. This work has been under way for a year, and we are now satisfied that we know how to proceed. A strong sponsoring committee has recently met, approved the plans, and appointed a sub-committee, which is now ready to push the work vigorously to conclusion. It would be of great assistance, therefore, if we could have an additional advance of \$750 whenever you find it convenient.
