My dear Doctor,

I am, as you see, in Europe for an investigation of the foreign clinics relative to rectal diseases.

It is my intention to return in the fall and to tour the South and South West for the purpose of holding ten or three day clinics at various colored hospitals during which time I shall lecture and demonstrate or operate as the occasion may arise. If it is possible to treat private cases also, I shall be very happy so that some advance publicity will be necessary in each city I may visit. I wish to acquaint members of my race in the South of the importance of rectal lesions. This is to be an educational program.

Would you be so kind as to send me a list of the hospitals which would lend interest to the above scheme. I intend to make this tour during next November - March. If you can send me the names of

the superintendent of each hospital, I  
can write to them & direct.
