Plan of Work

The social, cultural, and economic level at which the great majority of Negroes live suggest a quantitative difference in the needed educational equipment of teachers in secondary schools for Negroes. The purposes of this study are (1) to determine what these quantitative differences are, (2) to determine what educational equipment is needed by teachers who are to fill teaching positions in secondary schools for Negroes if the differences in emphases are to be observed, and (3) to formulate a teacher training curriculum for meeting the needs of the prospective teachers in secondary schools for Negroes.
